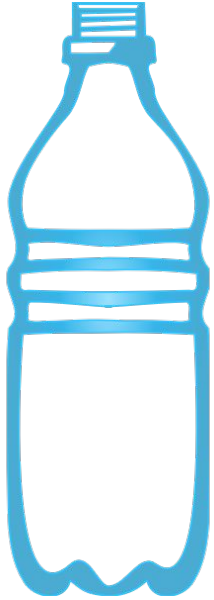

**Egyptian arabic regular
verb tenses 101**

Base Word - to drink



ثرب (sharab)



Past - I drank

ثَرَبْتُ (sharabt)

To Note:

- Action has been completed
- Suffix ت (t) added to the base form of the word

Simple Present - I drink

اشرب (ashrub)

To Note:

- Rarely used verb tense form

Present Continuous - I'm drinking

بِشْرِب (bashrub)

To Note:

- Prefix ب (b) attached to simple present verb form
- Frequently used for habitual actions, permanent conditions, and present continuous actions

Future - I will drink

هشرب (hashrub)

To Note:

- Prefix ه (ha) attached to simple present verb form
