

Egyptian arabic regular verb tenses 101

### **Base Word - to drink**



# (sharab) ثرب



### Past - I drank

## (sharabt) ثربت

To Note:

- Action has been completed
- Suffix ت (t) added to the base form of the word

### **Simple Present - I drink**

## (ashrub) اثرب

To Note:

• Rarely used verb tense form

### **Present Continuous - I'm drinking**

# (bashrub) بثرب

To Note:

- Prefix (b) attached to simple present verb form
- Frequently used for habitual actions, permanent conditions, and present continuous actions

### Future - I will drink

## (hashrub) هثرب

To Note:

• Prefix • (ha) attached to simple present verb form



Base word	Past	Simple present	Present cont.	Future
sharab	sharab <mark>t</mark>	ashrub	bashrub	hashrub
